- Pressure to perform
- High-stakes environments
- Lack of time management skills
- Lack of understanding of citation and referencing
- Peer influence
- Easy access to online information

STRATEGIES FOR IMPROVING ACADEMIC INTEGRITY

Educating Students about Academic Integrity

- Teach and provide guidance on proper citation and referencing techniques
- Define expectations and discuss ethical dilemmas
- Use technology tools to detect plagiarism

Promote a Culture of Academic Integrity

- Foster a supportive and ethical learning environment
- Incorporate academic integrity into the curriculum
- Recognize and reward integrity

Design Assessments that Discourage Dishonesty

- Design open-ended questions and project-based assessments
- Personalize assessments
- Focus on critical thinking and application
